Burning DVDS with iDVD

- 1. Launch iDVD from the dock or Applications folder. Click 'Create New Project' from the opening dialog box. Assign a file name and location. Choose 'standard' or 'widescreen' (Widescreen will work fine anywhere and probably be more useful).
- 2. Choose a theme from the right sidebar.
- 3. Drag the .MOV file from the desktop and drop it somewhere on the neutral area of the theme.
 - a. Don't drag the movie into the 'Drop Zone'. If you hover it over the drop zone, the zone will highlight with yellow and black line.
- 4. This is tricky: click the name of the .MOV file *once* to highlight it, then pause, then click it again to open it for editing. If you double-click, the DVD preview will start playing. If that happens, just click the stop button on the on-screen DVD controller. When you can edit the title, change the text to say 'Play Movie' or something like that. This will be your button.
- 5. Double-click the theme title and change that text to the title of your movie.
- 6. Open the 'Project' menu and click 'Autofill Dropzones'.
- 7. Insert a blank DVD into the drive on the right side of the computer; label faces up.
- 8. Click the 'Burn' button in the iDVD toolbar (it turns into a radiation symbol when pressed).
- 9. The DVD pops out when done. .DVDPROJ files take up lots of space, so it's best not to save the project file once you've burned the DVD. Click File→New Project to begin the next one.
